Tel Aviv University has a licence for on-line lectures and webinars up to 1000 students. So, all those who wish to participate in the teaching event will be welcome.

On 5th April Prof. Yosi Shacham will give a lecture "The future of Very Large-Scale Integration of Integrated Circuits" from 09:00 EET.

It was decided to publish an on-line table with the lecture/webinars/case studies for 203 dates and a Doodle table for each lecture in order to select the convenient date for all partners.

Jack Barokas will make the table in OneDrive of TAU. So, the Chinese partners who can not access Google docs could have access to the table.

It was decided that all teaching events will start at 9:00 CET or at 08:00 CET to respect the time difference between the different countries.



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Slavka said that we have to continue with the dissemination activities.

Jack proposed to describe briefly our new initiative to provide live lectures and webinars to the students and to disseminate it in the social media.

Varsha Kelkar proposed to write the material “Reaching beyond the realms for the learners across continents”. It will be published on the project Web site, in FaceBook, Twitter, Youtube etc.
